

ZSA's Mitered Corner Paper Model

Part 2 - turn work so you can read this

- 3) Imagine placing napkin in machine with edger on the blue boxes and beginning to stitch.
- 4) *Imagining the work in the machine,* unfold B1 & B2. **Fold Miter X on red line.** Refold B1 & B2.
- 5) You have created the mitered corner you need to navigate with your edger foot.

Edger foot

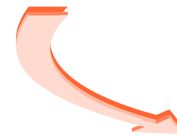

ZSA's Mitered Corner Paper Model
 Part 1 - turn work so you can read this

- 1) After printing both pages, tape back to back so dotted lines match on both sides.
- 2) Fold on Hem A1 & A2. Then Fold on Hem B1 & B2.

Miter X



Wrong Side

Hem A

FOLD A2 - Iron Second Fold Upward

FOLD A1 - Iron First Fold Upward

FOLD B2 - Iron Fourth Fold Upward

FOLD B1 - Iron Third Fold Upward

Right Side of fabric

Hem A

Both folds remain during sewing the corner
